# Legislative Report

November 2024

**Call for action** - Senator Elizabeth Dole 21st Century Veterans Healthcare and Benefits Improvement Act With a few scant weeks left in their session, members of the 118th Congress must act immediately or risk leaving generations of veterans, and their caregivers, with inadequate resources, lifealtering stress, and more questions than answers about their long-term health.

The bipartisan Senator Elizabeth Dole 21st Century Veterans Healthcare and Benefits Improvement Act (HR 542) addresses these issues and others, improving service-earned benefits and offering even wider upgrades to survivor programs, homeless veteran outreach, and many other facets of VA-provided support. Yet despite backing from key committee leaders and <u>dozens of veterans</u> <u>groups</u> (including MOAA), the bill has not cleared the House nor been introduced in the Senate.

Some of the key improvements: Home-Based Care Caregiver Help: Better Access to Care: Veterans would be able to find care from local providers

Even More Progress: The bill calls for greater oversight of the department's new electronic records system, increases funding and improves flexibility for programs supporting homeless veterans, and strengthens veteran education benefits, including expanded access to benefits for surviving spouses.
